Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How many Medicare Advantage plans are available?

A: You have access to three Medicare Advantage plans that include prescription drug coverage. The Standard Plan has a **\$0 monthly premium**.

Q: How do I get my prescriptions refilled?

A: You can fill prescriptions by visiting a pharmacy in your plan's network. Be sure to hand them your new Anthem Member ID card.

Another way to fill prescriptions is by using home delivery through CaredonRx Pharmacy. To set up your home delivery account, call us or log in to your [anthem.com](https://www.anthem.com) account.

Q: Does a deductible apply to select generic drugs and generic drugs?

A: No. The deductible is waived for select generic and generic drugs under this plan.

Q: Do my insurance premiums include my Medicare Part B premium?

A: You must keep paying your Medicare Part B premiums, unless they are paid by Medicaid or through another third party.
